Community Description:

Cartersville is approximately forty miles north of Atlanta, Georgia in Bartow County. With a population of 21,000 and ranked 38th in relative size among Georgia's cities, Cartersville boasts a rich standard of quality living. Visitors, as well as residents, recognize the balance of a culturally attractive, small town atmosphere. Cartersville is the home of several nationally recognized museums which is extraordinary for a community its size. The Booth Western Arts Museum houses the country's largest permanent exhibition space for western art, and also displays original works of every United States President. The Tellus Science Museum offers a world class, 120,000 square foot, interactive gallery dedicated to science exploration and exhibition including a state-of-the art planetarium. The Etowah Indian Mounds are the focus of the most intact display of Mississippian Culture in the southeast. Major industries that fuel a large portion of Cartersville's workforce include Anheuser Busch, Shaw Industries, TOYO Tires, and Georgia Power.

Cartersville High School is a comprehensive, four-year, public charter high school with an enrollment of 1407 students in grades 9-12.
