LEARNING FOCUS

Reading: We will learn different ways to show our understanding about fiction books using story maps, character webs, and summarizing strategies. The main strategies we will focus on will be discussing setting of stories and inferring. Guided reading groups will continue.

Phonics: We will be learning about how to read and spell with diphthongs oi and oy and trigraphs -tch and -dge. At the end of the month, we'll work on some more suffixes. Remember, our phonics assessments have changed and there is a reading component in addition to the spelling component. This should improve overall scores for struggling spellers.

Math: We are finishing unit 4 and moving on to Unit 5 which focuses on understanding place value up to 1,000. This includes being able to recognize numbers in standard form, Base 10 block form, word form, and expanded form. We will also be solving story problems involving money. Math homework offers a tiny glimpse of what we are doing in class. Basic facts should still be practiced at home with flashcards or online games through Clever if your child is still struggling with those.

Writing: This month in Writing we will begin focusing on our Informational Unit. We will learn to research a chosen topic, find important facts and write an informational piece about our topic. We will continue to use prior knowledge of sentence structure and parts of speech to improve our writing.
