# Northwest Georgia Regional Educational Agency The Georgia Teacher Academy For Preparation And Pedagogy (GaTAPPP)

### **GATAPP BASIC OVERVIEW**

The Georgia Teacher Academy for Preparation and Pedagogy (GaTAPP) is an alternative preparation program that leads to a renewable certification approved by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC).

**Time Frame:** An 18-month program for MOST candidates; no more than three years from date of entry OR at least one academic school year (2 semesters that must include the beginning of a school year). **Non-GACE CTAE** candidates can complete the program in one year.

#### GaTAPP is Designed For Individuals Who:

- Wish to transition into teaching from another career path;
- Have not completed a teacher education program
- \* Have never held a clear and renewable (professional) teaching certificate

# **GATAPP PROGRAM ENTRY CHECKLIST:**

- SECURE A TEACHING POSITION In the area you are seeking certification with a local school system. Candidates may not teach in a credit recovery lab or similar teaching assignment. This program requires that you have a position as a teacher for at least 50% of the school day in order to be considered for the program. Check with your HR Department to complete GaTAPP packet & forward to mharris@nwgaresa.com.
- ✓ PROVIDE COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS Have a degree from an accredited college or university with a GPA of 3.0 or higher (GPAs 2.5 2.9 will be considered). Mail OFFICIAL college transcripts to the address posted below or electronically to <a href="mailto:mharris@nwgaresa.com">mharris@nwgaresa.com</a>. (GaTAPP Coordinator will evaluate the official transcript).
- ✓ **MUST HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING** Pass the GACE Program Admission Assessment (or qualify for exemption with a passing score on the SAT or ACT). It is possible to exempt the GACE Program Admission Assessment if you passed the SAT with a Combined score of 1000, Verbal and Quantitative **OR** ACT exemption: Combined 43 English and Math). Proof of scores need to be forwarded to NWGA RESA GaTAPP Coordinator <u>sbandy@nwgaresa.com</u> OR Admin. Asst. <u>mharris@nwgaresa.com</u>, Address is posted below.
- ✓ TAKE & PASS the GACE 350 Ethics Assessment Modules Register through your MyPSC account this assessment can be taken on your own computer. Choose the Assessment tab in your MyPSC account to begin registration; then choose reason #7 "I am taking the Program Entry level of the Georgia Educator Ethics or the Georgia Ethics for Educational Leadership assessment". CHOOSE NorthWest GA RESA as a recipient of your scores. The cost is \$30.00.
- ✓ A MAJOR IN THE CONTENT AREA ALIGNED TO YOUR TEACHING POSITION OR Pass the GACE content assessment aligned to your field. Certain pathways do not require that the Candidate take and pass the GACE Content Assessment before being admitted into the program. Please note, the Candidate must pass this assessment before exiting the program.
- ✓ CREATE A MyPSC ACCOUNT AT <u>WWW.GAPSC.COM</u>: be sure to complete all required fields or your account is inactive.



### NWGa RESA GATAPP PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- CANDIDATES MUST ATTEND REQUIRED CLASSES AND PASS ASSESSMENTS & TASKS. Register for the Program
  and pay tuition prior to the first day of class by going to <a href="https://www.nwgaresa.com">www.nwgaresa.com</a>. The Essentials of Effective
  Teaching Class; ALL CANDIDATES MUST ATTEND. The next Essentials of Effective Teaching class is scheduled for
  JULY 9TH 20TH, 2018. Class Time: 9A 4P. Also, Candidates must attend Saturday Sessions, typically scheduled
  one Saturday a month from May August.

     Teaching of Reading (If applicable to certification)
     HB671 Exceptional Child (Online)
     Special Education Series (For SpEd Candidates)
  - Pass the following assessments during enrollment:
     Passing Score on edTPA,
     Passing score GACE 360 (Ethics Exit Assessment)
     Passing score on GACE Content Assessment
     Observations, Disposition Survey,
     GaTAPP Portfolio (Evidence of 24 Competencies) evaluation results are at a proficient or distinguished level
- TAPP candidates are issued an Induction 4 certificate, effective for three years. Once you have completed GaTAPP, the Induction 4 certificate will be reissued as an Induction 1 certificate. After three years in Induction (required for all new GA teachers), if all conditions are met, a new Professional Teaching certificate will be issued (to be renewed every 5 years).
- If you are a Special Education teacher, you will have additional coursework per special education requirements.
- Complete all online Canvas assignments and other assignments as assigned and pass edTPA.
- Candidates must maintain a disposition fitting a teacher whose conduct is professional, ethical and caring toward students, parents, and colleagues.
- Candidates should demonstrate the ability to complete technical writing and the ability to use technology both in and out of the classroom.
