



2019-2020 DIGITAL LEARNING DAY INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS

OVERVIEW

For future unexpected school closings, we may declare a “Digital Learning Day.” If a digital learning day is declared, teachers will provide assignments via Schoology, our learning management system, for students to complete at home. When possible, staff will also be available for virtual “office hours” through Schoology should students or parents have questions on the material or need assistance with the assignment.

CPS:

Reading assignment and Math assignment
OR students in “Challenge” classes will complete a Challenge assignment if this day is missed.

CES:

One 20-30 min. assignment in each of the following: Math, ELA, (OR EIP OR Challenge assignment if this day is missed) and specials assignment:

Mon/Wed/Fri

3rd – Music

4th – Art

5th – PE

Tues/Thurs

3rd – PE

4th – Music

5th – Art

CMS:

One 20-30 min. (max. time) assignment in each of their classes (6 total assignments)

CHS:

One 20-30 min (max. time) assignment in each of their classes (Maximum of 7 assignments depending on student schedule)

ASSIGNMENTS

- Assignments should be published in Schoology for student access by 9:00 a.m. on each declared Digital Learning Day.
- Students will have 5 school days upon returning to school to submit assignments.
- Teachers will provide feedback on assignments by one week after due date.
- Assignments are to be related to course standards and content.
- Assignments will not cover brand-new concepts except to preview upcoming material.
- Assignments will not require printing but parents/students can request a printed copy of assignments upon return to school.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Use Schoology regularly throughout the school year.
- Download the Schoology App to get notifications.
- Anticipate as much as possible when there may be a declared Digital Learning Day and take home all school materials that might be needed (books, novels, etc.).
