

The RESET Program is a specialized instructional environment for Cartersville Middle & High School students placed on long-term suspension. This program is for our $6^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade students who require a highly structured and secure environment that enables them to get their learning, behavior, and executive function skills back on track. The RESET learning model is a 1:1 technology-blended learning environment with both online and in-person instruction focusing on differentiation and project-based learning. Learning is also enhanced by providing interventions that support each student's academic and social-emotional needs.
