- Take any rescue medication early in the course of a headache for best effect. You should have it at school if needed.
- **Taking over-the-counter medications more than 3 times each week may lead to a medication-overuse headache.** This is a headache that occurs more often over time and requires higher doses of medications to reduce pain.
- **Take all medications with a full bottle of water or sports drink as part of treatment.**
