- We look at data, GMAS, CCRPI, and also the advanced Ed looked at their recommendations as well. Used this information to pull three goals out of it.
- Used classworks, study island, and gmas, and surveys from advanced ed for last year's data. SRI is given three times a year for the Lexile levels, not only fluency but comprehension.
- PowerSchool discipline ISS/OSS, for this year we are using all of those components except for classworks.
- USA Test Prep a program for pre assessments to determine the students' knowledge of the material. MI which is the Math component. Students who really struggle in reading are using Reads Naturally. SRI can even help with gifted.
- Goal 1: Procedures and Protocols for system wide collaborative learning structure and collaboration across grade levels. Teachers participate in weekly PLCs. They meet with instructional lead teachers to talk about vertical alignment, differentiation, so we can bridge gaps in instruction. We also give professional development days as well. If a teacher is struggling in classroom management then we get a sub to come in while the teacher observes other teachers.

- Teacher feature video: if a teacher goes to a conference, then they come back and video what they learned. Then share with all grade levels. Very positive!
- ESOL teachers are not only pulling kids out to a separate class, they are also pushing into the classrooms to help.
- Padgett Gilbert: Instructional Technology Lead who is going in the classroom and helping teachers
- Every Friday: admin, counselors, instructional leads
- Grading policy 60% summative 40% formative
- Goal 2: develop a systematic process, including professional development plan, for all professional and support staff in the implementation and use of data from multiple source to inform instruction, grading and reporting practices, program evaluation, and organizational effectiveness with discipline infractions and office referrals.
- Instructional Leads will show teachers strategies to better use formative assessments so they are successful on the summative assessments. Each teacher is using common benchmark assessments. SRI for example. Educator's Handbook to monitor office referrals.
- Goal 3: Develop and enhance student engagement.
- We want the students to be active learners in the classroom. Student centered instruction. Engaging activities. They are actively involved in the learning. Work on improving the communication between the school and parents. Whether Family Engagement night, Hurricane Heroes, or teams. Remind apps to help communication.
