Dual Enrollment

Students interested in Dual Enrollment should begin by checking eligibility with their counselor. Students will register for electives normally and will be placed into Dual Enrollment after they have been admitted to the college and had a parent conference with a school counselor.

Work Based Learning (WBL)

Students interested in leaving campus for Work Based Learning/ Youth Apprenticeship should see Ms. Boyer (Career Center) for an application. Applications are an interest form. Students should submit the application and register for electives that they would like. Applicants will meet with Ms. Boyer and notified of acceptance into the program - based on grades, discipline, courses taken, and attendance.

1. Choose 5 electives from the offerings on the other side of this sheet.
You may choose more than one elective in each department as long as you meet requirements.
Examples: Year-Long weight training, band, JROTC, etc. Or “doubling up” in a CTAE pathway (level 1 1st semester and level 2 2nd semester)
2. Carefully copy course names and numbers for your 4 elective requests and 1 alternate below.
3. Register for these courses online through Infinite Campus (2/7/24: WATCH THE VIDEO DURING 3RD BLOCK.)
4. You should return this form with the bottom portion completed and your requests entered in Infinite Campus by: **February 9, 2024 to your 3rd block teacher.**

Course Registration Guidelines:

- Any course with an asterisk (*) next to it must be taken first before all other subsequent courses
- Football (grades 9-11 only), Band, JROTC, and Chorus students must “double up” and take their courses for both semesters unless approved by the instructor for the course. (This uses **two** requests.)
- If you plan to take Dual Enrollment or Work Based Learning, you will not be able to register for those courses in Infinite Campus. You should register as though you will NOT be in either program next year. The WBL coordinator and/or your school counselor will talk with you to arrange your schedule if approved to participate in the program.
- You may register for yearbook (all grades) and mentorship (juniors and seniors only); however, you must complete an application for those courses. If you do not apply and get accepted, the course will be removed from your primary requests, and your alternate will be used.
