

- I. Old Business
 - a. Motion to approve January Minutes
 - b. Fundraiser –
 - i. Raised over \$23,000
 - ii. Will go toward STEAM initiative
 - iii. Additional playground needs/wants – soccer goals, basketball goals
 - c. Electives Updates
 - i. Spanish not likely for upcoming year
 - ii. OLA offered after school on-site for a cost (possible on Wednesdays)
 - d. Overnight Trips
 - i. Will have to put out for third-party companies to bid on
 - ii. Trips that are sole-source vendor do not require bidding process
 - iii. Patriots Point – Warship, 1 adult for every 5 kids (5th grade)
 - iv. Space Camp – Programming and lodging all on same site (4th grade)
 - v. Concerns for out-of-pocket expenses for parents
